- Paper submissions should follow the style guidelines of the <u>Journal of International</u> <u>Business Studies</u> (http://www.palgrave-journals.com/jibs/index.html) and must include a full list of all references cited in the paper.
- Irrespective of the type of paper submitted, all papers ought to use 11 point Times Roman font; A4 format with 2.5 cm margin on all sides; the word count excludes abstract (approximately 150 words), references and any of the appendices. A cover page should indicate the title of the paper, the name(s) of the author(s), and their affiliation(s). The first page should start with the title of the paper only, followed by an abstract not exceeding 150 words. The main body of the paper should follow the abstract.


