

Introduction

Slovenia is a country in Central Europe bordering the Adriatic Sea. Neighboring countries include Austria, Croatia, Hungary, and Italy. Despite its small size, Slovenia controls some of Europe's major transit routes. The Alps dominate northern Slovenia, and numerous rivers lie in the east. The government system is a parliamentary republic; the chief of state is the president, and the head of government is the prime minister. Slovenia has a mixed economic system in which the state is considerably involved in centralized planning, but there is private sector freedom. Slovenia is a member of the European Union (EU).

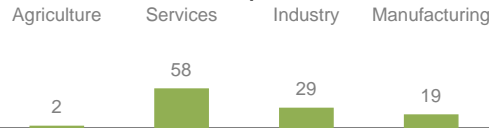

Risk Assessment (Provided by Coface)

Country rating: A3 - Changes in generally good but somewhat volatile political and economic environment can affect corporate payment behavior. - Small domestic market, very open economy (exports of goods and services represent 80% of GDP in 2020)
- Ageing population and demographic growth at a standstill, resulting in a labor shortage
- Dependence on regional economic conditions and automotive
- Inefficient state-owned companies
- Slow administrative and judicial procedures
