

Introduction

Andorra is a landlocked country in Southwestern Europe that borders France and Spain. Located in the Pyrenees Mountains, Andorra has a strategic location that straddles a



number of important crossroads in the mountains. The government system is a co-principality with the president of France and the bishop of Urgell (Spain) as coprinces. The president of France, in his

capacity of prince of Andorra, is the chief of state, and the head of government is the prime minister of Andorra. Andorra has a mixed economic system in which the

economy includes a variety of private freedom, combined with centralized economic planning and government regulation.
